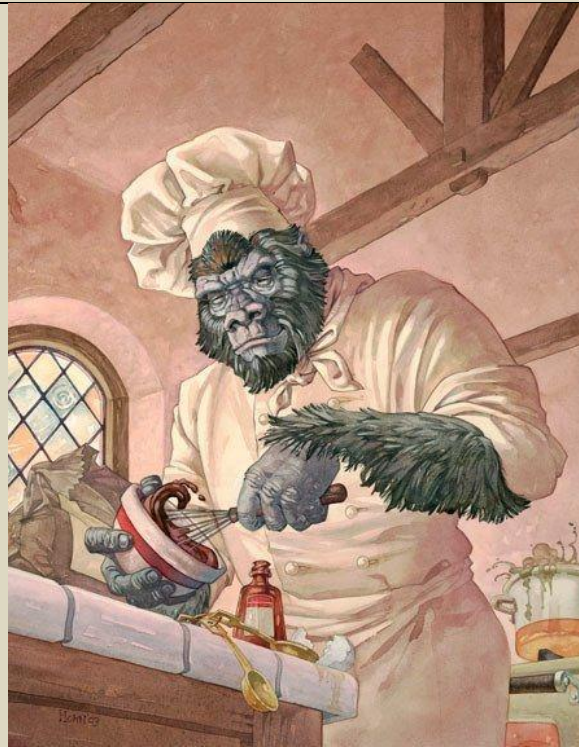

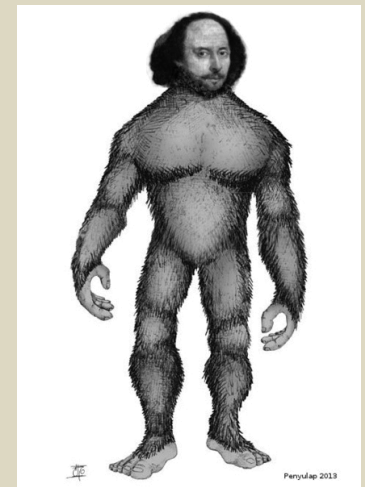


### What does Jeeves Know?
