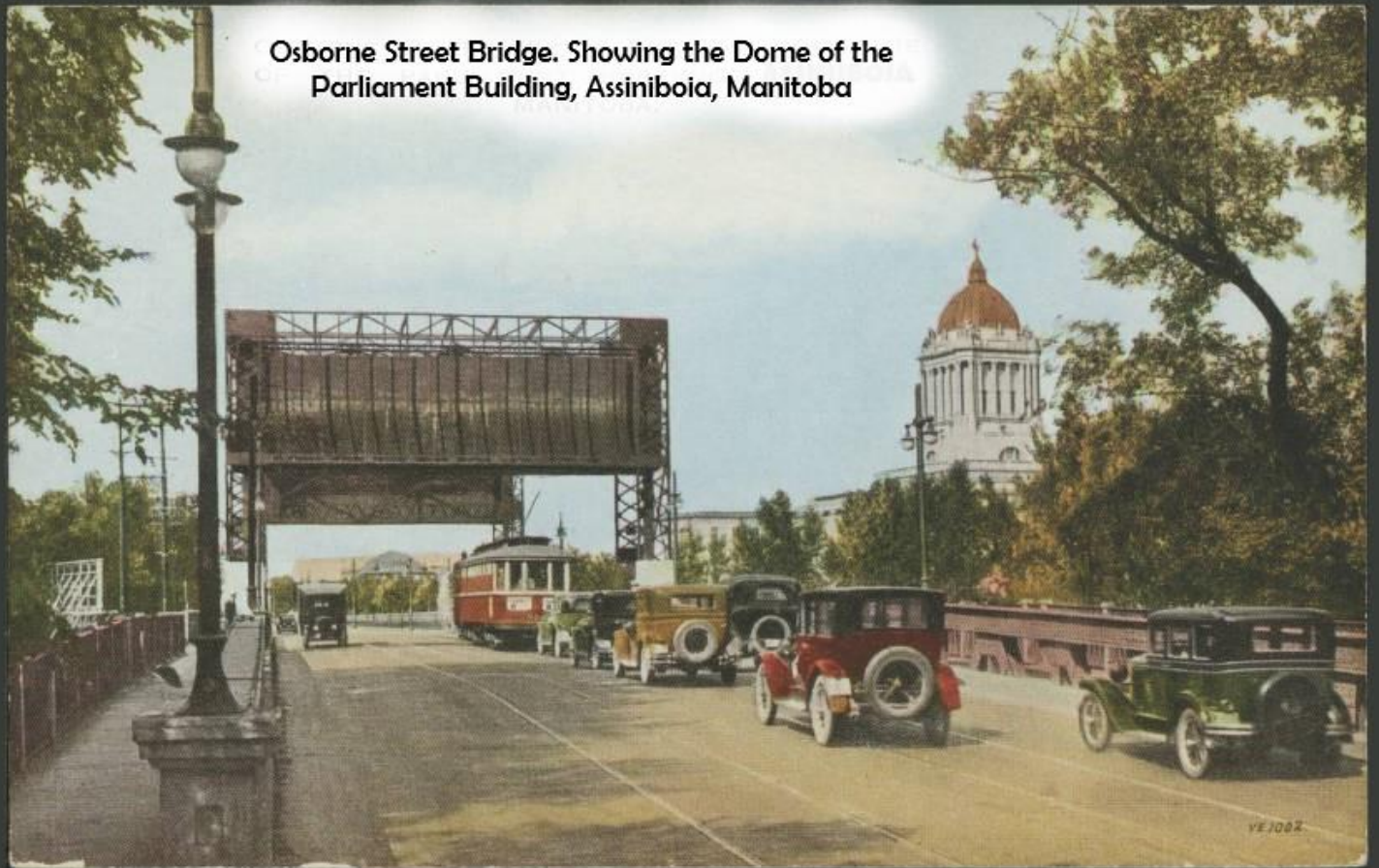

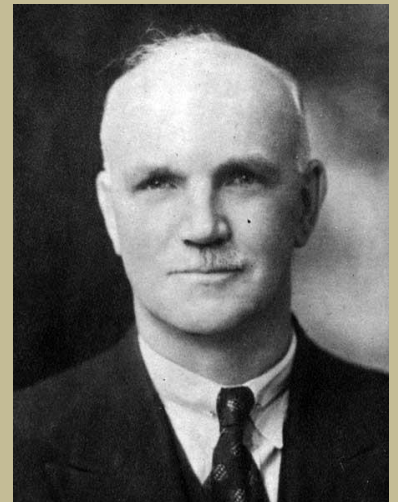
Osborne Street Bridge. Showing the Dome of the Parliament Building, Assiniboia, Manitoba



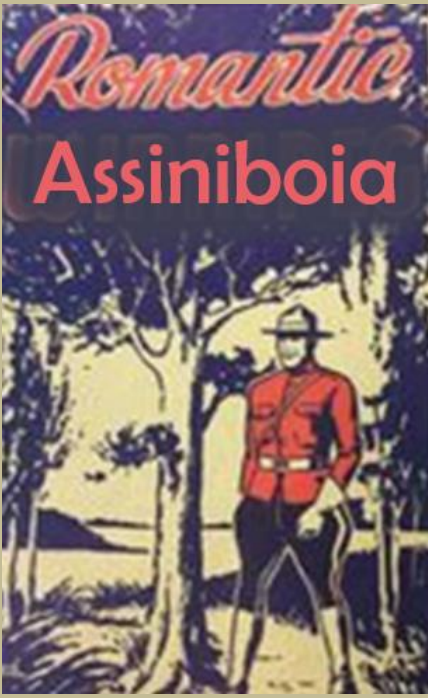
Our mayor Ralph Webb welcomes you to Assiniboia, Queen City of the North-west Provinces of the Dominion of Canada!

- Zeppelins...and more!



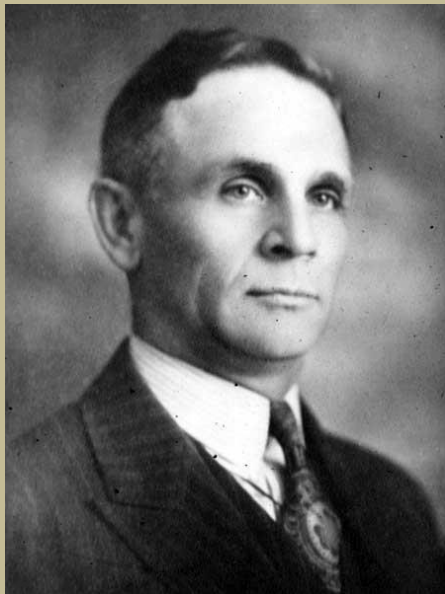

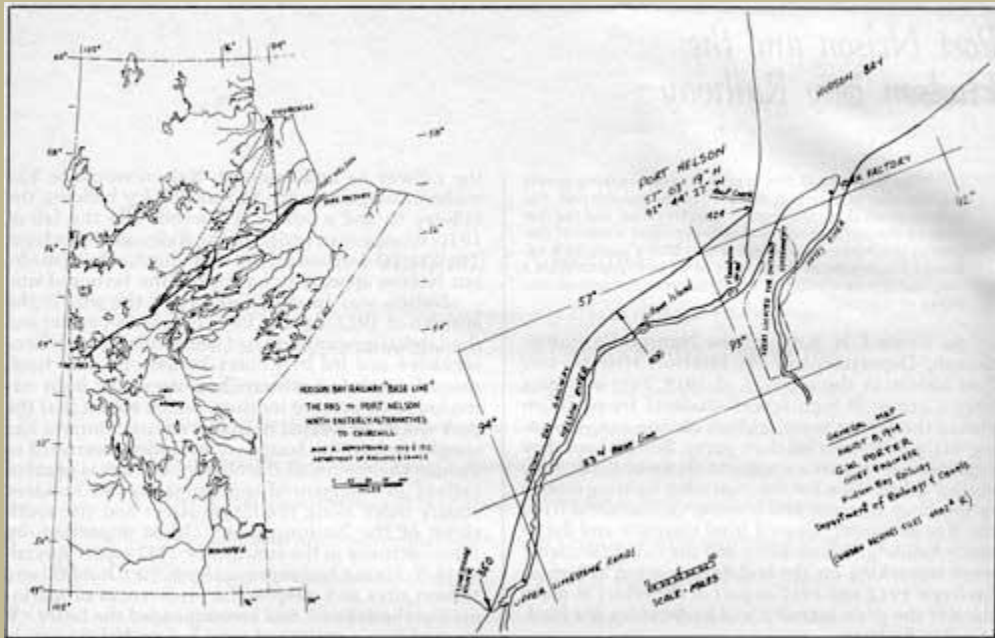
Our premier, the Honourable John Bracken extends the warmest welcome to visitors and invites you all to stay!
